**OUTDOOR WEBELOS LEADER (OWL)** training is a hands-on skills course in the outdoors, designed to help you master the basic camp skills required for taking your Webelos Scouts and their parents or guardians on a successful, memorable, and fun camp out. You will learn how to set up camp, cook, work with wood's tools and tie knots. Training also includes first aid, campfire program planning, health and safety procedures, camp sanitation, Webelos to Scout transition planning, outdoor oriented adventure pins, and much, much more.

**What other training do I need to earn the "Trained" patch?**

Webelos Den Leaders and Assistant Den Leaders are required to take the following courses:

- Youth Protection Training – online or face-to-face
- Den Leader Position Specific Training for Webelos Leaders

Required for All Webelos Den Leaders and Assistant Webelos Den Leaders; recommended for all Webelos volunteers who camp with their Scouts
