What is it?

Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training is a half-day program for adult leaders in scouting that prepares them for the day to day tasks of serving youth members of BSA programs. This is one of three training programs that must be completed in order for an adult to be considered trained to serve as a leader in their unit. This training focuses on the contents of the newly published Troop Leader Guidebook and outlines the essential elements of successful planning and execution of the scouting program.

Who should attend?

Any adult leader who wishes to serve as a Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster, Varsity Coach or Venturing Crew Leader. Additionally, any leader who completed their training before Spring of 2015 should consider this training, as the new Troop Leader Guidebook provides some fresh information that will be inspiring to even the most seasoned scouters.

How do I sign up?

Go to northstarbsa.org and to the calendar link at the top of the page. Click on the event on April 21st and you will be guided through the registration process. You can, also, click on the Training link to get to Adult Training registration and additional information.

The cost is \$10 (cheap).
