Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) is a hands-on skills training in the outdoors, designed to help you master basic camp skills required for Tenderfoot to First Class. You will learn how to set up camp, cook, work with wood tools and tie knots. Training, also, includes first aid, campfire program planning, map and compass skills, hiking and backpacking techniques, nature identification and Leave No Trace.

**What other training do I need to earn the “Trained” patch?**

Troop and Team Leaders are required to take the following courses:

- Youth Protection Training – in person or online\*
- Leader Position Specific Training for SM/ASM
- Hazardous Weather Training (SCO\_008) – online\*\*(new leaders as of 4/18)
